Techniques to Know

Form a Loop

Instructions:

- 1. Cut an 8" length of black copper wire. Form a tiny loop on one end of the wire.
- 2. Run fingers along the length of the wire, or use nylon jaw wire pliers, to straighten out the wire. String on the following: one large black e-bead, two black bugle beads, one large black e-bead, one medium red AB faceted bead, one large black e-bead, two black bugle beads, one large black e-bead, one medium red AB faceted bead, and three black bugle beads.
- 3. Use round nose pliers to form a tight loop snug up against the last bugle bead added in the previous step.
- 4. Repeat step 2, in reverse order.
- 5. Repeat step 3.
- 6. *Repeat steps 1-5, a total of four times. These beaded wire strands are the legs of the beaded spider.
- 7. Cut off the head on the end of a 3" head pin. Form a small loop on one end of the head pin. Slide the following onto the head pin: a small silver star bead cap, 10mm black glass bead, and a small silver star bead cap so the bead caps hug the bead.
- 8. Next, slide the middle loop on each set of legs onto the head pin.

- 9. Slide on another small silver star bead cap and a large red AB faceted bead so the bead cap hugs the bead from behind. Form a snug loop after the large red AB faceted bead and trim off any remaining head pin stem.
- 10. Arrange legs, on each side of the spider, so the spider stands up.

*Spider legs can be made longer or shorter by adding more bugle beads onto the legs.
