#40000594 Assorted Colors Sticky Back Foam Sheets, 12" x 9", 12 pc. (1 pk)

*#40000556 Vibrant Colors Sticky Back Foam Sheets, 6" x 9", 40 pc. (1 pk)

#40000759 Self Sealing Clear Bags, 8.75" x 11.75", 30 pc. (1 pk)

#40000636 Gold Jingle Bells, .75", 30 pc. (1 pk)

#35021012 Colors of The Rainbow 8mm Velvet Flocked Beds, 120 pc. (**1-2 pk)

#JNEED2254 Big Eye Beading Needles, 2.25", 4 pc. (1 pk)

#34734253 Bright Colors Embroidery Floss, 40 pc. (1 pk)

*Optional but allows for more color choices.

**One pk is enough to make a three wrapped candy garland. Two packs is enough to make up to a seven wrapped candy garland.

Tools & Supplies Needed

Scissors

Ruler

Pencil

Preformed Quarter Coin Wrappers (or make your own round candy pack shapes)

Techniques to Know

Basic Cutting

Tie a Knot

Tie a Basic Bow

Instructions: (Use photo images as a guide.)

1. Print and cut out the "candy pack" pattern piece. (If you don't have preformed quarter coin wrappers you can use this pattern piece to make your own.)
2. Tuck in the end of a quarter wrapper so it matches the width of the pattern piece from the previous step.
3. Trace pattern piece onto the back side of desired color foam sheet and cut out. Peel off the backing and securely press the foam sheet around the quarter coin wrapper so the ends meet to make a candy pack. Trim if necessary.
4. Cut out long strips from sheets of various colored sheets of foam for embellishments. Peel off the backing and press the strips around the candy pack.
5. Trim the sides off both edges of a self-sealed bag and open the bag up. Measure down approximately 8.5" from the self-seal strip on the bag and cut across the width of the bag at that length. Wrap this around the candy pack, remove the self-seal backing and press so the wrapper is secure around the wrapped candy pack.

6. Repeat steps 2-5 to make the desired number of “wrapped candy packs” for your garland.
7. Load one end of a skein of floss onto a beading needle.
8. String on fourteen flocked beads, one jingle bell, and fourteen flocked beads.
9. Slide the beading needle and floss through the middle of one of the candy packs. Twist the ends of the clear bag wrapper together on both ends of the candy pack. Cut four 12” lengths of floss in desired colors. Join two lengths of floss together and tie into a secure bow around the twisted wrapper on both ends of the candy pack. Trim excess floss tails.
10. Repeat steps 8 and 9 until you have added all your wrapped candy packs.
11. Repeat step 8 one more time.
12. Cut the floss so you have an extra 12” on each end. Form loops on both ends and tie floss into a knot to form hanging loops. Trim excess floss tails.
