#69991589 Orange In-Bloom Seed Bead/E-Bead/Bugle Bead Assortment (2-3 pk)
#6124601 Colors of The Rainbow Seed Bead Mix (2 pk)
*#14780 Plastic Cupettes, set of 16 (1 pk) (*optional but helpful)
Orange Acrylic Paint
Red Acrylic Paint
Green Acrylic Paint
Unfinished Wood Harvest Sign (or another Thanksgiving themed sign)
Mod Podge
Spray Acrylic Sealer Gloss Finish

Tools Needed

Foam Paint Brush Cookie Sheets or Trays, 2 Wax or Parchment Paper Skewer of Bead Reamer

Techniques to Know

Basic Painting

Instructions:

- 1. Cover cookie sheets or trays with wax or parchment paper.
- 2. Use paint brush and orange paint to paint the words on the sign. Rinse out paint brush. Use paint brush and red and green paint to paint the leaf on the sign. Allow to dry. Rinse out paint brush.
- 3. Use paint brush to generously coat the top of the word section of the sign with a layer of mod podge. Move the sign to a new tray covered w/ parchment paper.
- 4. Sprinkle orange seed beads, small bugle beads, and glitter over the words on the sign, catching loose beads and glitter on the paper. (If the spaces between some of the letters fill in with beads, use skewer or bead reamer to push those beads down through the sign.)
- 5. Move the sign to a new cookie sheet or tray covered with wax or parchment paper. Gather the beads left over from the previous step and sprinkle them over the words on the sign.

- 6. Repeat steps 4 & 5 until as many seed beads and as much glitter as possible has adhered to the surface. Allow to dry thoroughly.
- 7. Using the same techniques from steps 3-6 sprinkle red, yellow, and orange seed beads onto the leaf section of the sign until the leaf is thoroughly covered with beads. Allow to dry thoroughly.
- 8. In a well-ventilated area, spray a coat of sealer gloss onto the sign to help prevent seed beads and glitter from falling off. Allow to dry. Repeat this step 1-2 more times until beads no longer fall off.
