

Turtle Father's Day Card

Supplies Needed

#40000583 Light Green 12" x 18" 2mm Foam Sheet (1) #40000925 Assorted Self Stick Wiggle Eyes, 200 pc. (1 pk) #40000788 Multicolor ¾" Pompoms, 45 pc. (1-2 pk) #40000790 Kelly Green ½" Pompoms, 100 pc. (1 pk) #40000812 Yellow 10mm Pompoms, 100 pc. (1 pk)

Tools & Other Supplies Needed

Downloadable Hand Turtle Template (or trace around child's hand and add a head) Scissors Ruler Skewer, toothpick, or bead reamer (to score underneath the fold) Black Marker Child Safe Clear Drying Glue Small Plastic Container (for glue dipping)

Techniques to Know

Basic Cutting, Gluing, and Printing

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Fold green foam sheet in half lengthwise. Trace hand turtle shape onto the top layer of the green foam sheet so the top of the turtle lines up with the fold. Cut out the turtle shape so the turtle card opens on the fold. (Using a ruler and bead reamer, skewer, or toothpick as a tool to "score" a line underneath the fold will help the card close better.)
- 2. Squeeze glue in the bottom of a dipping dish.
- 3. Dip pompoms into glue and glue them onto the turtle "shell".
- 4. Glue wiggle eye onto the turtle head.
- 5. Use marker to draw a mouth, toes, and write a Father's Day greeting inside the card.
