Snail Version #1 Instructions:

1. Choose a color and coil a single chenille stem around a pencil.
2. Choose two chenille stems of a different color. Lay them side by side and slide them through the coiled chenille stem until approximately 3" of the two stems are on one side of the coil. Tightly roll and spiral the other end of the two stems together. Form a slight curve in the coiled chenille stem and position the spiral so it lays above the coiled chenille stem.
3. Separate the chenille stems coming through the other side of the coil. Spiral the ends of each chenille stem where you will place the snail eyes. Remove the adhesive backing from two wiggle eyes and place them onto the spiraled stem ends.

Snail Version #2 Instructions:

1. Choose two same chenille stems colors and one different chenille stem color.
2. Lay the three chenille stems side by side with the different color in the middle. Pinch the three stems together.
3. Begin tightly rolling and spiraling one end of the three side by side chenille stems together. When you are approximately 3" from the end of the chenille stems, cut a 3" tail off the middle stem. Cut that tail in half and form each half into a spiral. Set those aside.
4. Spiral the ends of the two remaining 3" chenille stems where you will place the snail eyes. Remove the adhesive backing from two wiggle eyes and place them onto the spiraled stem ends.

Snail Version #3 Instructions:

1. Choose two different colored chenille stems. Lay them side by side and begin spiraling one end of the stems into a snail shell shape until you are approximately 3" from the other end of the stems. Bring those ends straight out from the spiral shell and bend them back into a narrow loop that meets the snail's shell. Glue the ends of the stems onto the snail shell.
2. Cut a 5" length of another chenille stem. Twist the middle of that onto the middle of the narrow loop from the previous step so the two ends stand up. Spiral both ends where you will place the snail eyes. Remove the adhesive backing from two wiggle eyes and place them onto the spiraled stem ends.
