



## Pompom Desk Mirror

### Supplies Needed

#40000665 Round 7" Mirror (1)

#40000788 Multicolor  $\frac{3}{4}$ " Pompoms, 45 pc. (1 pk)

#40000530 Wooden Dowel Rods,  $\frac{1}{4}$ " x 12", Natural Finish, 10 pc. (1 pk)

### Tools & Other Supplies Needed

Glue Gun

Ruler

Wire Cutters or Small Hand Saw

### Techniques to Know

Basic Gluing and Wood Cutting

### INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Choose four each of eight different colored pompoms.
2. Arrange one set of each of the eight colored pompoms into desired sequence.
3. Use glue gun to glue one set of pompoms around  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the edge of the mirror. Repeat gluing the other three sets of pompoms evenly around the remaining  $\frac{3}{4}$  edge of the mirror.
4. Cut three wooden dowels to a length of 10" each.
5. Use glue gun to glue two of the dowels, flat, and on angles, to the back of the mirror (see illustration). Glue the remaining dowel, between the two previous dowels, so it points away from the mirror creating a tripod stand.
