## Techniques to Know

Instructions: (We chose to remove the brown and black e-beads from the ebead mix.)

1. Cut a 24 " length of beading wire. If you have a bead stopper, place it on one end of the beading wire.
2. Create you own 18 " asymmetrical strand of pearls and e-beads or use the following as a guide: (In this step, single 4 mm gold jump ring will be referred to as $j r$, a single 6 mm pearl will be referred to as 6 mm , and a single 8 mm pearl will be referred to as 8 mm ). String the following onto the beading wire: $13 / 4$ " of mixed color e-beads, (jr, 8 mm , $j r$ ), $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of mixed color e-beads, ( $j r, 6 m m, j r$ ), $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ mixed color e-beads, ( $j r, 6 m m, j r, 8 m m, j r$ ), $1^{\prime \prime}$ of mixed color e-beads, ( $j r, 6 m m$, $j r), 2^{\prime \prime}$ if mixed color e-beads, ( $j r, 6 \mathrm{~mm}, j r$ ), $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ of mixed color e-beads, ( $j r, 8 \mathrm{~mm}$, $j r, 6 m m, j r), 1 \frac{1 / 4 "}{}$ of mixed color e-beads, (jr, $8 \mathrm{~mm}, j r$ ), $13 / 4$ " of mixed color ebeads, ( $j r, 8 m m, j r, 6 m m, j r$ ), $1^{\prime \prime}$ of mixed color e-beads, ( $j r, 6 m m, j r$ ), and $3^{\prime \prime}$ of mixed color e-beads. Use crimp tubes to connect each end of the beaded strand to 4 mm jump rings.
3. Cut a 16-17" length of gold cable curb chain and attach 4 mm jump rings to each end. Cut a 21 " length of gold cable chain and attach 4 mm jump rings to each end.
4. Slide an 8 mm pearl, a 4 mm jump ring, and two different colored e-beads onto a head pin. Trim the stem and form a loop to make a beaded drop. Slide an e-bead, a 4 mm jump ring, a 6 mm pearl, a 4 mm jump ring, and a different color e-bead onto an eye pin. Trim the stem and form a loop to make a beaded link. Attach one end of the beaded link to the loop on the beaded drop.
Connect the loop on the other end of the beaded link to the middle link of the 21 " of gold cable chain.
5. Attach a 6 mm jump ring to the loop on a lobster clasp. Connect the 4 mm jump rings on one end of the following, in order, to the 6 mm jump ring on the lobster clasp: curb chain, beaded strand, cable chain.
6. In the same order as the previous step, connect a 6 mm jump ring to the 4 mm jump rings on the other ends of the chains and bead strand. Connect that 6 mm jump ring to another 6 mm jump ring.
