## Techniques to Know

Jump Rings

Form a Loop

Crimp Tubes

Cutting Chain

## Instructions:

1. Slide the following onto a 3" gold head pin: three 4mm gold rounds, one blue e-bead, three 4mm gold rounds, one short clear bugle bead, one turquoise bugle bead, and one 4mm gold round. Trim the stem of the head pin and form a loop to make a beaded drop. Attach a 6mm jump ring to the top loop of the beaded drop. Repeat this step to make a total of fourteen beaded drops.
2. Slide the following onto a 3" gold head pin: ½" of blue e-beads, one 4mm gold round, ½" of blue e-beads, one short clear bugle bead, one turquoise bugle bead, one 4mm gold round, one turquoise bugle bead, and one short clear bugle bead. Trim the stem of the head pin and form a loop to make a beaded drop. Attach a 6mm jump ring to the top loop of the beaded drop. Repeat this step to make a total of 28 beaded drops.
3. In the following order, gather the jump rings of the following beaded drops onto a single 6mm jump ring: one beaded drop from step 1, four from step 2, and one from step 1. Close the jump ring and attach one more 6mm jump ring

to that jump ring. (This last 6mm jump ring will be referred to as the top jump ring on the group of beaded drops.) Repeat this step for a total of seven groups of gathered beaded drops.

4. Cut a 24" length of beading wire. (\*If you have bead stoppers, place one on one end of the wire to help hold beads on while stringing. The bead stopper can be moved back and forth between the ends of the beading wire as you work.)

5. String the following onto the middle of the beading wire: one blue e-bead, one turquoise bugle bead, one blue e-bead, one 6mm gold round, the top jump ring of a group of gathered beaded drops, and one 6mm gold round. Repeat this sequence six more times. String on one blue e-bead, one turquoise bugle bead, and one blue e-bead to complete the middle of the necklace.

6. String five 6mm gold rounds onto one side of the necklace.

7. Continue by stringing the following onto that side of the necklace: one blue e-bead and five 6mm gold rounds. Repeat this step four more times.

8. Repeat steps 6 & 7 onto the other side of the necklace.

9. Attach a 4mm jump ring to a lobster clasp. Use a crimp tube to connect the wire on one end of the necklace to that 4mm jump ring.

10. Cut a 2-3" length of extender chain. Attach a 6mm jump ring to one end of the extender chain. Use a crimp tube to connect the wire on the other end of the necklace to that 6mm jump ring.

11. Slide the following onto a gold head pin: one 5mm gold round, one 4mm gold round, one blue e-bead, two 4mm gold rounds, one short clear bugle bead, one turquoise bugle bead, and one 4mm gold round. Trim the stem of the head pin and form a loop to make a beaded drop. Attach the loop on this beaded drop to the other end of the extender chain.
