Glitter Foam Wreath Ornament

Techniques to Know

Basic Tracing & Cutting Hot Glue Gun Double Knot

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Print and cut out pattern pieces on heavy weight paper.
- 2. Choose wreath color. Trace wreath pattern onto back side of foam sheet and cut out.
- 3. Fold wreath shape in half, length wise, so glitter is on the inside of the fold. Cut slits along the fold where indicated. Carefully place hot glue along the edge (as indicated on the pattern.) Fold the piece around so glitter side is facing up, and the hot glue meets the corresponding edge on the back side of the wreath. Press both edges so hot glue adheres them together.
- 4. Trace and cut out bow and center ribbon on the back of desired colors of glitter foam.
- 5. Use hot glue to glue the center ribbon onto the bow. Use hot glue to glue the ribbon onto the front top of the wreath to cover where the wreath was glued together.

- 6. Cut a 12" length of iridescent silver cord. Bring the middle of the cord through the middle of the top slit of the wreath. Tie the ends together to make a hanging loop for your ornament.
- 7. Repeat the above steps to make multiple wreath ornaments.
