



## FOR YOU DAD MACRAME BRACELET

### Supplies Needed

#34733001 Tan, Dark Brown Wood & Acrylic Bead Mix, 150G (1 pk)  
#65018100 Natural Polished Black Hemp Cord, 328.2' (1 pk)  
#47554111 Crystal Glue Pen (\*1 pk) \*Can substitute any craft glue that dries clear

### Tools Needed

Ruler  
Scissors  
Scotch Tape

### Techniques to Know (See Illustrations)

Square Knot  
Overhand Knot

### Instructions:

1. Cut two 18" lengths of hemp cord. Place the two cords side by side. Tape one end of the two cords onto work surface so the tails of those cords are facing towards you.
2. Cut one 30" length of cord. Approximately 5" from the taped cord ends, slide the middle of the 30" length of cord underneath the two 18" cords. Form the 30" cord, around the 18" cords, into two square knots. You now have four working cords, two outside cords and two inside cords.
3. Slide a light brown corrugated I bead wood barrel bead onto each outside cord. Bring all four cords together and tie the two outside cords, around the two middle cords, into a square knot.
4. Slide an off-white round wood bead onto the two middle cords. Bring all four cords together and tie the two outside cords, around the two middle cords, into a square knot.
5. Repeat steps 3 and 4 five more times.
6. Repeat step 3 one more time.
7. Tie the two outside cords, around the two inside cords, into one secure square knot. Apply a dab of glue onto the last knot and allow to dry. Trim excess cord tails from that knot. This leaves the two middle cords.
8. Cut a 6" length of cord. Crisscross the two cords from each end of the bracelet. Use scotch tape near each end of the four crisscrossed cords. Slide the middle of the 6" length of cord underneath the middle of the crisscrossed cords. Form the 6" cord, around the crisscrossed cords, into 3-4 square knots. Apply a dab of glue onto the last

knot and allow to dry. Trim off the excess tails of the 6" length of cord. These square knots make an adjustable closure for the bracelet.

9. Slide a barrel bead onto each of the cords on both ends of the bracelet. Determine where you want those beads to be positioned onto the cords. Tie each cord end into an overhand knot, before and after each bead, to secure the beads onto the cord. Apply a dab of glue onto each knot and allow to dry. Trim excess cord tails.
