



## POSITIVE ENERGY LAYERED NECKLACE & EARRINGS

### Techniques to Know:

Jump Rings  
Cutting Chain  
Form a Loop  
Crimp Tubes

### DIRECTIONS:

#### Necklace

1. Remove blue bugle beads from the dark blue multi strand necklace.
2. Cut a 34" length of beading wire. Use a crimp tube to attach a 4mm jump ring to one end of the wire.
3. String one bugle bead and one bronze e-bead onto the beading wire. Repeat this pattern to make a beaded strand approximately 27" long. Use a crimp tube to attach a 4mm jump ring to the other end of the bead strand. Trim wire tails.
4. Cut the following lengths of chain: 24", 21", and 18".

5. Attach 4mm jump rings to both ends of each length of chain.
6. Use a 6mm jump ring to gather up the 4mm jump rings on one side of each of the following, in order: beaded strand, 24" chain, 21" chain, and 16" chain. Attach another 6mm jump ring to the first 6mm jump ring. Use a 4mm jump ring to attach a lobster clasp to the previous 6mm jump ring.
7. Use a 6mm jump ring to gather up the 4mm jump rings on the other side of each of the following, in order: beaded strand, 24" chain, 21" chain, and 16" chain. Attach another 6mm jump ring to the first 6mm jump ring. Attach another 6mm jump ring to the previous 6mm jump ring. Attach the lobster clasp (from the other side of the necklace) to the last 6mm jump ring added in this step.
8. Remove the silver jump ring from the small gold circle/gold bead charm from the brown tone multi charm pack. Remove a matte blue e-bead from the multi strand necklace. Slide that bead onto an eye pin and form a loop to make a bead link. Attach one end of the bead link to the hole on the top of that charm.
9. Use 4mm jump rings to attach the following charms to the middle links on the following lengths of chain: charm from previous step to the 16" chain, hamsa hand charm to the 21" chain, and the elephant charm to the 24" chain.

### **Earring Instructions:**

1. Remove two matte blue e-beads and two shiny blue e-beads from the dark blue multi strand necklace.
2. Slide a matte blue e-bead, bronze e-bead, and matte blue e-bead onto an eye pin and form a loop to make a bead link.
3. Attach the loop on the shiny blue e-bead side of the bead link to the bottom loop of an ear wire.
4. Attach the loop on the matte blue e-bead side of the bead link to the loop on top of a hamsa hand charm.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for the matching earring.

**Skill Level:** Intermediate

**Approximate Crafting Time:** 1-2 hours
