



## Supplies Needed

#61215033 Red 11/0 Glass Seed Beads, 40G (1 pk)  
#3201802 Silver 24 Gauge Copper Wire, 40' (1 pk)  
#34774091 Silver Metal Hoops w/ Plastic Backs, 4 pc. (1 pk)  
#77707162\* Swarovski Siam 10mm (side drilled) Hearts (1 pk) (\*additional design option)  
#2950248\* Silver Plated 6mm Open Jump Rings, 28 pc. (1 pk) (\*additional design option)  
#34737053 Bead Mat, 9" x 12" (1)

## Tools Needed

Flush Cutters  
Bent Nose Pliers  
Needle Nose Pliers  
Ruler

## INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a 20" length of wire. Form a small loop near one end of the wire. Bring the loop around the base of the hoop, just behind the ball on the end of an earring hoop. Bring the wire back through the loop and use pliers to pull the wire taught and close the loop securely around the base of the earring hoop. Test to see if wire is secure on hoop. If necessary, form another loop and repeat. Trim off the tail of wire on this end.
2. Load 13" of seed beads onto the wire. Slide the beads all the way down the wire to meet the hoop. Bring the end of the wire back through the last seed bead loaded onto wire, leaving the wire tail intact.
3. Coil the beaded wire strand around and around the base of the earring hoop until you cover the earring base and reach the stem end of the earring hoop.
4. Form a small loop at that end of wire, bring the loop around the end of the base of the earring hoop. Bring the end of wire through the loop and use pliers to pull the wire taught so the loop holds the wire securely on the hoop. Test to see if wire is securely attached onto the earring base. If necessary, form another loop and repeat. Trim off the wire tail.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for the matching earring.

**DESIGN EMBELLISHMENT OPTION:** (After completing the basic earrings.)

1. Cut an 8" length of wire.
2. String the following onto the middle of the wire: 5 seed beads, one side drilled heart, and 5 seed beads.
3. Join the wire ends together just after the seed beads on each side. Twist the wires together once or twice. Form the wire ends together into a wrapped loop and trim the wire tails to make a beaded drop.
4. Adjust the wrapped loop and use a jump ring to attach the beaded drop to the bottom of the earring hoop, between the coiled seed bead strand, so it hang downs at the bottom of the earring.
5. Repeat steps 1-4 for the matching earring.
